1 Corinthians 1:3:9



The only hope-Living by the Holy Spirits power.



‘When anyone hears the Word of the Kingdom, and does not understand it, then the wicked one comes and snatches away what was sown in his heart. This is he who received seed by the wayside’, Matthew 13:19.

Add. Reading; Matthew 13:18-23 / Acts 5:29-39 / Daniel. 7:15-28 / Exodus 33:17-19.

Let us pray: ‘Loving Heavenly Father, at this critical time in our world’s history may Your Holy Spirit be at work showing men and women that their hearts will find rest only when they believe in Your unchanging SON and His unshakeable Kingdom, O Father, in God we trust, the more I reflect on this the more grateful I become that I belong to an unshakeable Kingdom, things may shake around me, but, nothing shakes inside of me, You are mine and I am Yours, in Jesus name thankyou O Heavenly Father, amen.

This months Word we learn; living by The Holy Spirits power to be with faith and hope as we walk in the Spirit and not by sight, in Jesus name. No matter how long we have walked with God, our flesh never improves; it never becomes more like the Spirit over time! That’s why we are told to crucify it and walk each day by the power God’s indwelling Spirit provides. Listen: ‘...obey only The Holy Spirits instructions... then you will not always be doing the wrong things your evil nature wants you to do...’ we naturally love to do evil things that are just the opposite from the things The Holy Spirit tells us to do; and the good things we want to do when the Spirit has His way with us are just the opposite of our natural desires. These two forces within us are constantly fighting each other to win control over us, and our wishes are never free from their pressures. Galatians 5:17.

When other things fail maybe we all will come round to seeing and practicing the principles given by a great leader Jesus many years ago of the principles delineated at the Sermon on the Mount! We needed a goal, something to give life meaning as a Christian we find we all are to God the fragrance of Christ among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing, (2 Cor. 2:15), and we see through this blessing of what we were searching for was the Kingdom of God, but at the time through trials we were not aware of it! But when The Holy Spirit controls our lives He will produce this kind of fruit of hope in us; love, joy, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.

(Gal. 5:22-23). Is such a lifestyle possible we may ask? Yes, but you must do four things:

#1- you recognize that you are a target for the enemy and protect yourself with God’s Word and prayer.

#2- and get rid of the one sin that repeatedly defeats you: ‘...lay aside...the sin which so easily ensnares...’ (Hebrews 12:1).

#3- to be continually filled with The Holy Spirit’s power, without it you lose every time.

#4- and stand in God’s strength, not of your own. How? By fighting until you experience victory, of His might, plus your choice to obey and keep on fighting. Always lead to a clear and lasting victory! Amen.

Doesn’t this help beloved explaining the driving force behind so many of the revolts and campaigns taking place in the world? People are searching for the Kingdom of God with out being aware that they are doing so! Dare we hope beloved that in the shaking that is going on in this generation men and women will come to see that their only hope is to belong to a Kingdom that is immoveable-the unshakeable Kingdom of God, amen.
